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TYPECON2008

Buffalo is food town. Like the many fine establishments to be found in the largest city in New York State, Buffalo restaurants abide by Darwinian principles: only the fittest eateries survive—there is little room for bad food. In the greater Buffalo area, you can find just about any type of cuisine imaginable. Ethnic Slavic and Italian markets assure fresh and diverse ingredients and the intrepid gourmand will be rewarded with minimal effort.

Buffalo is known internationally for its significant contribution to pop cuisine, the **hot chicken wing**. For a lesser known Buffalonian gastronomic delicacy, try a **Beef-on-Weck**. This taste sensation is a hot roast beef sandwich on a Kimmelweck roll (*a hard roll with coarse salt and caraway seeds*) slathered in horseradish. When well made, it's truly a fine thing. To prove its standing as a food-loving city, Buffalo hosts the second largest food festival in the US each summer. The 2008 **Taste-of-Buffalo** occurs the weekend before **TypeCon**, so early arrivals can sample over 150 culinary specialties within a half-mile radius, give or take.

For **TypeCon2008**, we have assembled a hand-picked listing of restaurants near the downtown Hyatt Regency, as well as some lying a bit farther afield. If there is something else you're in the mood for, just ask a local. Everyone has an opinion, but the following will give you a good head start on a wide range of eats.
